Parental Consultations

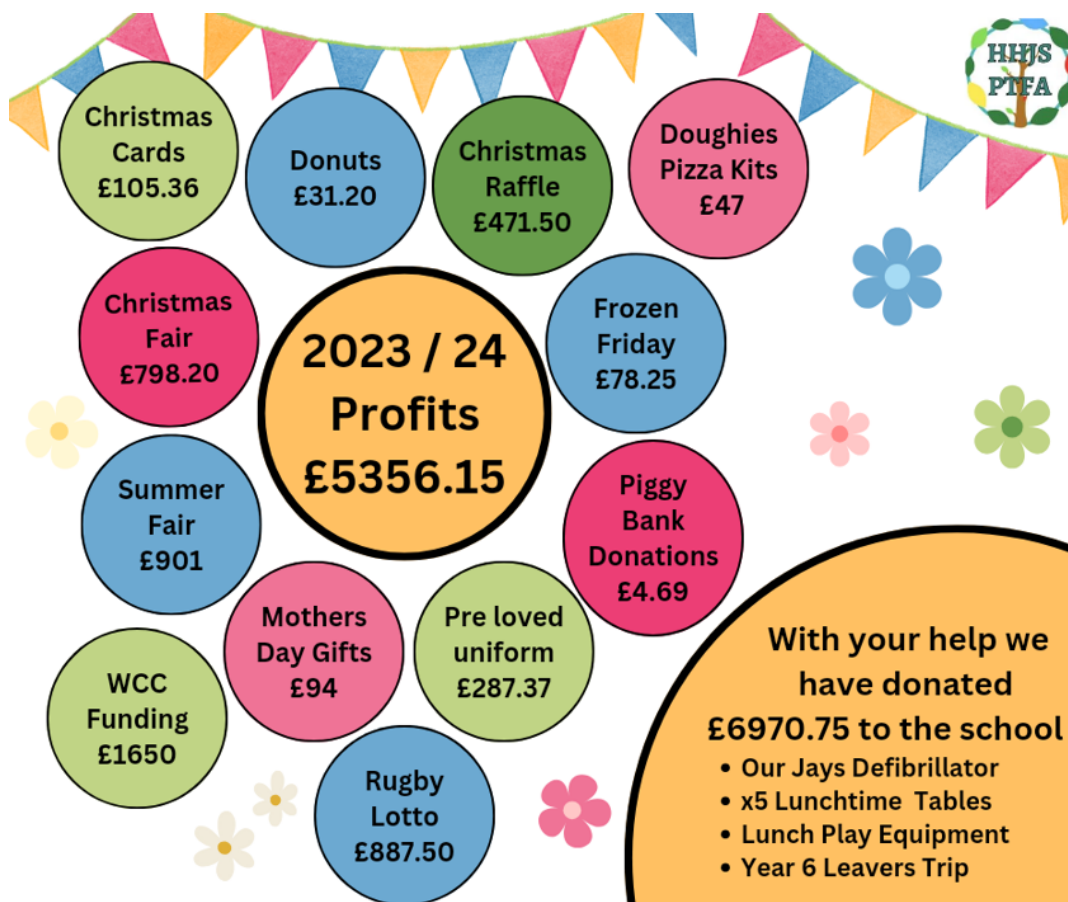
