Year 2—Bridget Riley—weaving art cross linking all things wonderful

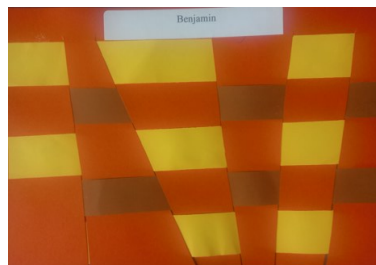
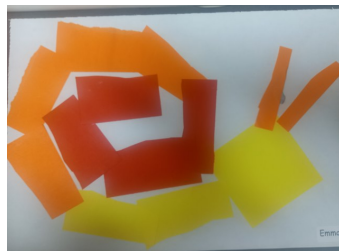

You are welcome to attend our annual Sports Afternoon at the Grenville site on Monday 1st July. For those who have attended before, it is the same format as previous years.

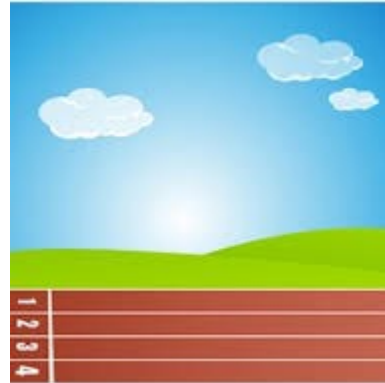
The children will come out onto the field at 1:30pm in their classes and sit on mats by the track. There will be chairs out for you.
