Year 4 Viking Day

The Viking School Days will be bringing history to life in our classrooms, on Thursday 16th January 2020 for 4 Willow and Friday 17th January 2020 for 4 Cherry.

Each class will have a full day of interactive study with a Viking character, presenting the saga of his life as a 10th Century Norse raider, trader and settler in the British Isles. His story is focused on the Viking and Anglo Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England against the backdrop of King Athelstan's clash with the Vikings at the Battle of Brunanburh.

Forest Schools

This term all classes will be taught Forest School on a two weekly cycle for a whole afternoon with a qualified Forest School instructor. We'd like children to have their forest school kit in school at all times, taking it home after their session to wash before bringing back. **Every child will need**; waterproof jacket and trousers, fleecy or other warm tracksuit bottoms, a long sleeved top, warm jumper or fleece, hat and gloves and a pair of wellington boots.
