This week, we've been busy building up to NSPCC Number Day 2020 today! Please visit our cake sale this afternoon where treats range from 20p to 50p so please come and check it out. If it's dry, we'll be hosting on the front playground, if it's not we'll be in 3 Maple selling for charity.

Looking to next half term, we have World Book Day on March 5th where we will be raising the profile of reading at bedtime by doing a whole school pyjama day. **Children do not need to bring in £1** to do this, but we do ask that they bring their favourite book to share with a friend. According to research, 43% of children were reading daily in 2015 compared to just 26% now. Our aim is to continue to raise the profile of reading in and out of school. On that note, if you'd like to come in and hear readers in school we would be very appreciative!

Parents of Year 4 and 6, keep your eyes peeled for important dates in your weekly Learning letters as after half term there will be some important information evenings for you. One, for Year 4, will be an information meeting about the Multiplication Table Check. As a school, we will have a 3-week check window, starting on Monday 8 June, to administer the Multiplication Table Check. Teachers will have the flexibility to administer the check to individual pupils, small groups or a whole class at the same time. The second, for Year 6, will be a SATs information evening. If you have a child in Year 6, in May, they will take National Curriculum tests in English grammar, punctuation and spelling, English reading and mathematics. The tests help measure the progress pupils have made and identify if they need additional support in a certain area. The tests are also used to assess schools' performance and to produce national performance data.

Also, Thursday was a bitter sweet day for staff and pupils here at Henry Hinde Junior School as one of our most loved members of staff started her well earned Maternity Leave today. She will be greatly missed in school but what an exciting new chapter she is beginning. Don't panic thoughwe will keep you posted on any baby news in the near future!

School Kitchen Vacancies


