This is a teacher-led national network of schools focused on improving school performance through peer-to-peer challenge and knowledge sharing. Each school involved with Challenge Partners receives an annual Quality Assurance Review which is what we have had this week. This review is a peer review involving senior leaders from other schools in the partnership and was led by a current Ofsted Inspector. The review focuses on School Improvement Strategies, Quality of Teaching, Learning and Assessment and Outcomes for Pupils.

As you will know, our last Ofsted inspection was in November 2018 and as a school who wants to continue to improve, with the support from our trust we joined Challenge Partners which gives us the opportunity to focus on areas of improvement and to celebrate the strengths of our amazing school and staff team.
