This review is a peer review involving senior leaders from other schools in the partnership and was lead by a current Ofsted Inspector. The review focuses on School Improvement Strategies, Quality of Teaching, Learning and Assessment and Outcomes for Pupils.

As you will know, our last Ofsted inspection was in November 2018 and as a school who wants to continue to improve, with the support from our trust we joined Challenge Partners which gives us the opportunity to focus on areas of improvement and to celebrate the strengths of our amazing school and staff team. I look forward to sharing the report with you in the coming weeks.


Finally, I would like to wish you all a happy and healthy half term. Stay safe.
