It was lovely to welcome the children back into school on Monday all looking refreshed and ready for learning.

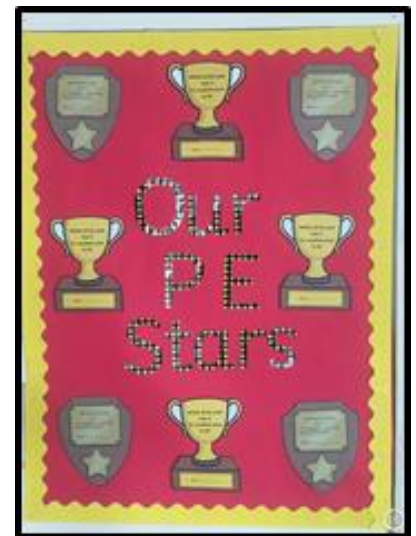

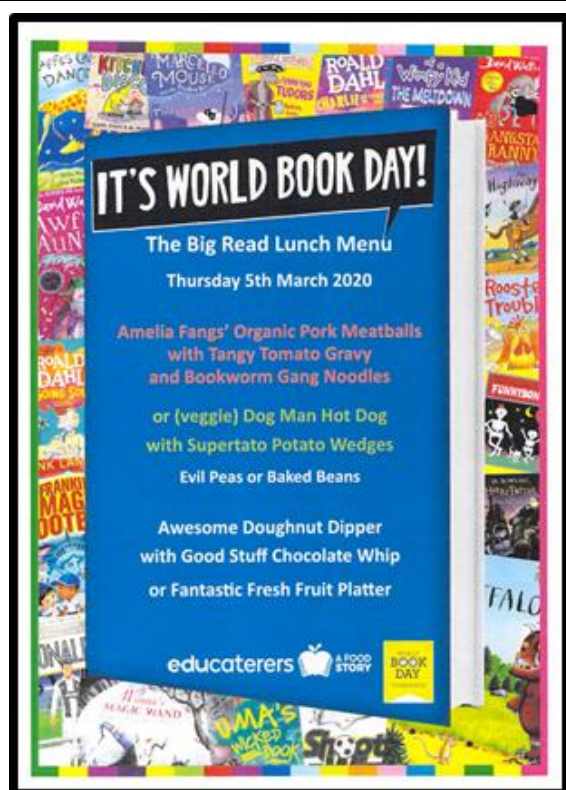
